At Hatton Vale State School, we believe that learning is a partnership between students, parents and teachers. These Learning Statements have been designed to provide families with what your child will be learning and assessed on this term.

In English, students will:

- use reading strategies to develop their accuracy, fluency and comprehension including:
 - inferring
 - finding details
 - predicting
 - adjusting and applying different reading rates
- demonstrate reading accuracy, fluency and exploring vocabulary in different texts
- read picture books and stories from different cultures
- write a retell of a traditional or cultural story

In Mathematics, students will:

- recall addition and subtraction number facts and solve addition and subtraction problems
- identify one half and describe partitioning of collections to represent one half
- collect data by asking questions, draw and describe data displays and make simple inferences

In Science, students will:

- explore sources of light and sound
- manipulate materials to observe how light and sound are produced
- demonstrate how changes can be made to light and sound effects
- respond to questions and sort and share observations

In Health and Physical Education (HPE), students will:

- understand that health messages promote ideas for healthy living
- recognise benefits of healthy food choices, exercise and hygiene
- commence an introduction to water safety and develop confidence in water
- learn basic swimming strokes (freestyle, and backstroke) and survival techniques

In the Arts, students will:

- make artworks in different forms to express their ideas, observations and imagination, using different techniques and processes
- develop aural skills by exploring and imitating sounds, pitch and rhythm patterns using voice, movement and body percussion
- create compositions and perform music to communicate ideas to an audience.
