At Hatton Vale State School, we believe that learning is a partnership between students, parents and teachers. These Learning Statements have been designed to provide families with what your child will be learning and assessed on this term.

### In English, students will:

- use reading strategies to develop their accuracy, fluency and comprehension including:
  - o author's purpose
  - o make predictions
  - o cause and effect
  - o tune into interesting words
  - retell the story
  - use text features
- Plan, write and edit a persuasive text

#### In Mathematics, students will:

- tell time to the guarter hour
- represent flips, slides and turns
- predict the likelihood of an event based on data; represent and interpret data
- interpret simple maps of familiar locations

#### In Science, students will:

- investigate natural resources on Earth and describe how they are used and the importance of conservation
- propose, communicate and justify actions that can be taken to conserve the Earth's resources

## In Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS), students will:

- identify past and present technology in their homes
- pose questions and locate information from different sources
- sequence different technologies in order
- explain how technologies have changed over time

## In Health and Physical Education (HPE), students will:

- continue water safety awareness and develop confidence in water
- learn swimming strokes (freestyle, and backstroke) and survival techniques
- examine safety clues that can be used in situations and explore the emotions felt in response to safe/unsafe situations
- consider different aspects of sun safety and how they can promote health, safety and wellbeing.

## In the Arts, students will:

- develop aural skills by exploring, imitating sounds, pitch and rhythm patterns using voice, movement and body percussion
- create composition and perform music to communicate ideas to an audience
- explore self-portrait representations
- · explore how changes in facial features, style and form communicate emotion in portraiture
