Year 5 Term Overview Term 4 2023



Aligned to the Australian Curriculum

At Hatton Vale State School, we believe that learning is a partnership between students, parents and teachers. These Learning Statements have been designed to provide families with what your child will be learning and assessed on this term.

In English, students will:

- use reading strategies to develop their accuracy, fluency and comprehension including:
 - compare and contrast
 - o recalling facts and details
 - o distinguishing between fact and opinion
 - o voracious reading (frequently reading and re-reading a wide variety of texts)
 - o adjust and apply different reading rates
- listen to, read and view TV episodes and texts with a range of characters and involving flashbacks or shifts in time
- demonstrate understanding of the depiction of characters, setting, events and issues in a chosen TV episode and text
- create a written comparison of a text and the TV adaptation and justify their preference
- use a variety of sentence types, topic specific vocabulary and accurate spelling in their writing

In Mathematics, students will:

- identify and use factors and multiples
- read and represent 24-hour time and convert between 12-hour and 24-hour time
- describe and order chance events expressing probability on a numerical continuum

In Science, students will:

- investigate, compare and contrast the observable properties and behaviours of solids, liquids and gases
- represent data and observations in tables and graphs

In Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS), students will:

- develop an understanding of the values of Australia's democratic system of government
- describe different views on how to respond to a community issue or challenge
- identify the importance of values and processes to Australia's democracy
- work with others to create a plan of action for a school identified issue

In Health and Physical Education (HPE), students will:

- explore the skills, concepts and rules of 'soffe cross'
- apply the appropriate techniques required to cradle, scoop, catch, pass, and shoot in modified games
- explore concepts of health and wellbeing and the importance of healthy habits as a preventative measure
- investigate the benefits that contribute to healthy habits

In the Arts, students will:

- rehearse and perform music they have composed by improvising, sourcing and arranging ideas and making decisions to engage an audience
- explore dynamics and expression, using aural skills to identify and perform rhythm and pitch pattern
- explore the purpose of music videos and work collaboratively to create a music video

In AUSLAN (Languages), students will:

- use sign language to communicate appropriately by sharing and responding to questions
- Demonstrate how AUSLAN is a combination of signs, expression and body language
